1.	Jean des Vignes, Blanc Sec, Vin de Pays du Gers (France) A crisp, refreshing dry white, of real character, made from Colombard and Ugni Blanc.	£12.45
2.	Sauvignon Blanc, Casa Rivas, Maipo Valley (Chile) This is clean and fresh with aromas of ripe grapefruit and lemon zest.	£13.45
3.	Chardonnay, Casa Rivas, Maipo Valley (Chile) Neat balance of oak and Chardonnay; a touch of spice and unexpected elegance.	£13.45
4.	Touraine Sauvignon 'Les Collines', Domaine de la Bergerie, J. Marteau (Loire) Fresh and enticing flavours of cut grass, bell peppers and yellow fruits with lively citrus acidity.	£13.95
5.	Sauvignon Blanc, Highwood, McLaren Vale (South Australia) A good example of a fresh, zesty Sauvignon. Clean, flavoursome and appealing.	£14.95
6.	Pinot Grigio, Il Colle, Veneto (Italy) Dry white from the northeast in a gentle, fruity and lightly spicy style.	£14.95
7.	Chardonnay 'Reserva', Casa Rivas, Maipo Valley (Chile) Butter, vanilla, ripe melons and a touch of citrus balanced by fine oak.	£16.50
8.	Riesling, Peak Winery, Clare Valley (South Australia) Soft and delicate citrus flavours with a clean, dry finish. Classic Clare Valley Riesling.	£16.95
9.	Pinot Grigio, Endrizzi, Trentino (Italy) A great example of Pinot Grigio. Soft angelica characters lie behind flavours of wild pears.	£17.50
10.	Sauvignon Blanc, Forrest Estate, Marlborough (New Zealand) Tropical fruit, vibrant acidity, irresistible appeal; the classic New Zealand Sauvignon.	£18.45

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| 11. | Sancerre, 'Terroirs' Domaine Sylvain Bailly (Loire)
Fresh, grapey fruit with a steely edge and fine mineral finish. | £22.95 |
| 12. | Pouilly-Fumé 'Fine Caillottes', J. Pabiot (Loire)
Smoky, mineral character of traditional Pouilly-Fumé from a fine, old-fashioned domaine. | £22.95 |
| 13. | Chablis 1er Cru 'Montmains', J-M. Brocard (Burgundy)
A fine Premier Cru Chablis, combining appetising elegance and depth of flavour.

| 14. | Les Bastions Rosé, Côtes de Saint-Mont, Plaimont (France)
Flavours of red fruits, delightfully fresh, with appealing softness. | £12.45 |
| 15. | Rosé, Forrest Estate, Marlborough (New Zealand)
Vibrant pomegranate pink in colour, with flavours of raspberries, blueberries and redcurrants, a touch of sweetness and a hint of tannin. | £15.50 |

| 16. | Gotas de Plata Brut, La Mancha (Spain)
Made from 100% Airen, this has good fruit and a lively, clean finish. The perfect party fizz. | £14.95 |

Delightfully deep pink in colour with aromas and flavours of crushed strawberries. The perfect aperitif. | £16.25 |
| 18. | Chardonnay/Pinot Noir Brut, Beresford (South Australia)
65% Chardonnay, 35% Pinot Noir from their Langhorne Creek estate. Genuinely elegant. Ripe flavours and a lingering fresh acidity. | £18.95 |
| 19. | The Adnams Selection Champagne, Brut
Fresh, yeasty aromas with stylish elegance of flavour. The true character of fine champagne. | £31.95 |

| 20. | Jean des Vignes Rouges, Vin de Pays du Gers (France)
An appetising red, made from a mixture of local Gascon grape varieties and a pleasing helping of Merlot. | £12.45 |
| 21. | Epoto, Tampranillo, Tierra de Castilla y León (Spain)
Soft, round black fruit flavours with an edge of Iberian spice. | £12.95 |

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| 22. | Merlot, Casa Rivas, Maipo Valley (Chile)
Lively purple-red in colour. Bright and vivacious with soft, ripe plum and summer fruit flavours. | £13.45 |
| 23. | Cabernet Sauvignon, Casa Rivas, Maipo Valley (Chile)
Well-structured and generous example of this classic Bordeaux grape. | £13.45 |
| 24. | Château Crecy, Bordeaux Rouge (Bordeaux)
Good luncheon Claret with soft blackcurrant fruit. | £13.50 |
| 25. | Côtes-du-Rhône, Château du Grand Moulas (Rhône)
Classic flavours of red fruit, thyme and pepper. A long standing favourite. | £14.25 |
| 26. | Merlot, Highwood, Langhorne Creek (South Australia)
Fine, ripe plum flavours with a touch of leather. A lovely balance of substance and purity of fruit. | £14.95 |
| <u>Red Wines Continued</u> | | |
| 27. | Beaujolais, Domaine de Milhomme (Beaujolais)
True Beaujolais from a local grower. This is a soft and juicy Gamay with flavours of summer fruits. | £14.95 |
| 28. | LZ, Rioja, Telmo Rodriguez (Spain)
Uncluttered by oak, this is a true expression of the juicy, red-fruit character of Tempranillo. | £14.95 |
| 29. | The Adnams Selection, Chilean Estate, Maipo Valley (Chile)
Unmistakeably Chilean - bursting with flavour, rippling with intensity. This is a delicious Cabernet Sauvignon, rich with flavours of blackcurrants and spice. | £15.45 |
| 30. | Nebbiolo d'Alba 'Mirine' Paolo Manzone, Piedmonte (Italy)
Wonderfully intense example of Nebbiolo. Juicy black fruit flavours with hints of game and walnuts. | £17.95 |
| 31. | Crozes Hermitage, Domaine Barret (Rhône)
Ripe Syrah fruit - red berries and hints of pepper. A fine example from a stony vineyard. | £18.25 |
| 32. | Pinot Noir, Forrest Estate, Marlborough (New Zealand)
Tightly structured, this has gamey, red fruit flavours and classic Pinot texture. | £18.50 |

33. **Château Chantelys, Médoc (Bordeaux)** £21.75
Classic Bordeaux with a hint of violets. Soft tannins balance intense, yet refined, fruit.

34. **Chassagne-Montrachet, Domaine Henri Germain (Burgundy)** £29.95
Aromas of raspberries and redcurrants, with cherry-stone leanness of flavour. Very moreish.

Dessert Wines and Port

35. **The Adnams Collection, Fine Dessert Wine, Pacherenc de Vic Bilh, Plaimont (France)** £12.50
The aromas of mandarins and candied citrus peel. Sweet honeyed fruit with a dry edge that makes this a perfect partner to strawberries, fine patisserie and all manner of puddings. 50cl bottle

36. **Late Harvest Riesling, Forrest Estate, Marlborough (New Zealand)** £16.25
Intensely perfumed, spice, honey and raisins. Sweet, beautifully balanced and fine texture in the mouth. 37.5cl bottle

37. **Quinta do Crasto, Traditional Late Bottled Vintage** £17.50
Deliciously intense, full flavoured and long. Powerful and peppery, with ripe flavours of raisins and dried figs.
